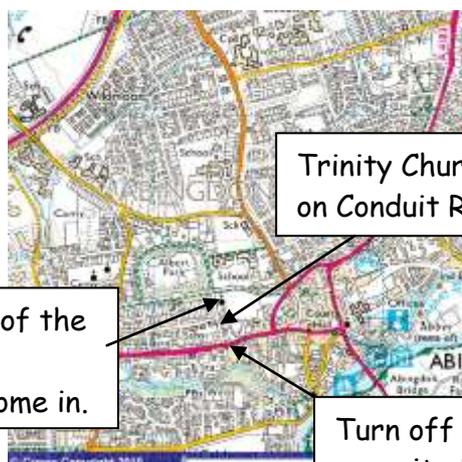

How to find us:



Trinity Church is on Conduit Road in Abingdon

The church itself is to the left of the church complex.
Please use the **front doors** to come in.

Turn off Ock Street opposite Knight's hardware

Parking: Limited on-street parking directly outside the church can be reserved on request.

Cloakroom: We will provide any materials/equipment which the children need.
While we do have space for coats, it would be helpful if bags could be left behind.

Arrival: **The time you have been given is for the start of the session. Please arrive promptly.**

To enable the sessions to run effectively, we ask that you organise the children into six mixed ability groups before you arrive. The children will need to know these groups & stay in them throughout their session. Each group should have an accompanying adult.

Discipline: We aim to create a quiet atmosphere of mutual respect, where there is minimal need for assertive discipline. The volunteer staff in the workshops are there as storytellers and we would ask the accompanying adults to take responsibility for their own groups. Individual children finding it difficult to maintain concentration can be taken aside to walk through the Labyrinth of Life, or use the SEN resources provided in the foyer.

Pastoral care:

Some of the workshops deal with sensitive issues and staff may wish to ensure that children with personal difficulties stay with them, rather than with accompanying adults. Should any children become upset, or wish to talk through personal problems, a quiet room and trained, DBS checked staff are available.

Disability access:

Ramp access is available at the front of the church, as is a disabled toilet.
One workshop is up three steps.
Children sit on the floor for most workshops, but chairs can be provided.

Follow-up: Each class teacher will be given a full script and sets of follow-up worksheets.
